League Age Determination:

The BCB age is the age of your child as of 08/31/25 for BOYS and 12/31/24 for GIRLS 4-15-yrs-old. Due to Little League rules BCB will strictly observe the age rules. All players must reside in the Boardman School District, attend a school in BCB's boundary map or obtain a LL waiver. For Boys this includes the South Range School District. Late and Final Registration:

THANKS FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING.

BCB Policies:

ALL 10, 11 & 12-YEAR-OLD BOYS AND 10, 11 & 12-YEAR-OLD GIRLS MUST REGISTER PRIOR TO TRYOUTS ON MARCH 15, 2025.

Those who do not, will be on a waiting list to play in Boardman Community Baseball this season. ALL players in this age group must participate in tryouts. Those who elect <u>NOT</u> to participate in tryouts will be drafted to a Varsity or JV Division team. Those boys who cannot attend the March 15 tryouts must contact their player agent to be excused.

PLEASE COME EQUIPPED WITH A GLOVE, HELMET AND BAT TO TRYOUTS, IF POSSIBLE. BATS WILL BE AVAILABLE.

Major Boys & Girls Draft:

BCB OPERATES UNDER ONE LITTLE LEAGUE CHARTER - BCB LITTLE LEAGUE. THE DRAFT SYSTEM FOR THE 2025 SEASON WILL BE A RE-DRAFT OF THE VARSITY/JUNIOR VARSITY/MINOR BOYS AND VARSITY/JUNIOR VARSITY GIRLS DIVISIONS. THERE WILL BE 6-7 TEAMS IN ONE DIVISION FOR THE BOYS VARSITY AND 1-3 TEAMS FOR THE GIRLS VARSITY DIVISION. Boy's & Girl's managers will observe ALL players trying out. Following tryouts the managers will draft players to their respective team. All drafted players should receive a phone call from the manager within 48 hours of the draft date (March 17-20, 2025).

Boys 4 thru 12:

All 4 & 5-yr-old boys will be assigned directly to a Mushball team. Six & 7-year-old boys will be assigned directly to a Minor Team. Coaches pitch at the Minor level. Previous evaluations will be reviewed for 7 thru 8-year-old boys to ensure that the talent level is evenly distributed amongst the teams in each division.

All 8-yr-old boys will be considered for the Minor Draft. 8-yr-old boys have the option of being considered and entering the Junior Varsity draft and can tryout (see below the time by age). Any 8-yr-old that is not drafted to a Junior Varsity team will be drafted to a Minor team.

10-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Varsity draft (see below the time by age). Any 10-yr-old that is not drafted to a Varsity team will enter the Junior Varsity draft.

Any 11-yr-old player not drafted to a Varsity team will enter the Junior Varsity draft.

All 12-yr-old players will be drafted to a Varsity team unless parents make a specific request to play in the Junior Varsity Division.

Boys 13 thru 18:

PONY LEAGUE/LL JUNIOR LEAGUE (AGES 13-14-YR-OLDS):

This year in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues, players will be allowed to play in other Leagues (i.e. Class B 14U) while playing in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues. The COLT League will also allow play in other leagues.

Managers are NOT required to give these players any special consideration.

There will be at least 2-3 teams in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues, all participating in the Tri-T/LL & Jr. Leagues for 2025. Fundraising:

In our continuing effort to raise funds to support our baseball programs and our complex, Boardman Community Baseball needs your help to make our fundraiser a success.

Our goal is to raise \$25,000 dollars via our fundraiser. BCB is a private self-supporting operation that receives no financial support from the township, county, state or federal agencies. The main source of income to support our facility and operations is the hosting of tournaments and the annual fundraiser that we ask each player (up to two per family) to participate in. Again this year we have included the fundraiser in the registration fee.

The cost of the fundraiser is \$50/player. We will supply each player with \$60 worth of DISCOUNT CARDS with community business discounts. After players sell all of their cards, it will actually serve as a \$10 discount on the cost of your registration fee. We THANK YOU in advance for your support of the fundraiser and we hope your player will sell the discount cards to take advantage of the \$10 discount. Cards will be mailed to players home starting the beginning of March.

New LL Residency Rule:

In 2014 Little League changed the residency boundary rule regarding where a player lives and the Little League they can play in. Each Little League organization has a boundary map by which their players must reside to play in said league. Now if a student attends a school that is within the league's boundary that player can play in said league regardless of their community residence. Proof of attendance is required from the school's administration. Schools included within BCB's Boundary Map include South Range Schools, Kirkmere Elementary, St. Charles, St. Christine and Valley Christian School.
